Budget revision:

Car show/carnival income goal of \$600 changed to \$100. Expenses changed from \$500 to \$100. \$80.40 was spent on candy that was going to be used for the carnival but is now being used for the giving drive.

The family scavenger hunt is being cancelled, the \$200 that was going to be used for that is going to cover costs for the giving drive.

Envelopes for cash and check donations being sent home, with a coloring sheet for kids to draw a picture of their act of kindness. Weekend challenges set for both weekends of drive, prizes have been ordered. Half way through our budget for the Giving Drive, remainder will go to all school prizes. Kickoff slideshow at assembly on Feb 28th. Family Campus Cleanup Day on Sat March 7th. Evites will be sent for it so we know how many people to expect. Volunteers needed to cut flyers and bag rocks to be sent home.

Posters will be put up around school on the 27th after school to surprise the kids on the kickoff day of the 28th.

Box Tops: Spring Submission deadline February 24th, mailed by March 1st.

Binglow on March 20th: Need volunteers to set up. Shorter event this year, will still have intermission.
