## **ONGOING BUSINESS**

The District adapted a new curriculum so new materials were needed. Instead of \$15/ student we were able to get some materials from the dollar store instead and were able to bring the total down to \$2/student. Leftover \$ from last years budget will go to fund this. We will volunteer to help prep the materials for the teachers.

Spirit Wear forms will be out 1st week of Oct. We looked over the new design and spoke about cold weather gear options. The magnets and stickers are done and available for purchase on our website. Sticker \$5, Magnet \$10. We will have these out for purchase at all our events too.

## Fundraising:

The Community Sponsorship Program is going well. We've raised \$3,000.00 so far. The T-shirts for all 330 students will cost about \$2,000.00. Our goal is \$7,000.00 raised so we can have \$5,000.00 for our budget. Teachers will fill out rosters for their students sizes. Every single student gets a t-shirt, no cost to them. We discussed ordering sample sizes to help teachers accurately fill out forms.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

The school's binding machine is broken. The teachers did use it and need another one, which we will purchase for them. There is a good one on Amazon for \$50 and \$500 in our Tech Fund that can be used toward it. We unanimously approved this purchase.

Parent Night Out Fundraiser - 9/27/19 - it helps fund 5th grade camp in January which costs \$250/student. Tickets for Parent Night Out are available now on our website.

Oct. Movie Night - 10/25/19 - will be Aladdin. There will be pumpkin painting for \$5/ pumpkin. The movie is still \$5/family. There will be a meal deal available of hot dog and chips.

One family donated \$1,000.00 to be used for PE and dietary/well being education. They have met with Mrs. Chase and decided how this will be spent. Mrs. Chase will be in charge of those purchases. We thank the family greatly for giving to our school!
